#### PUT YOUR FEET UP

Embroidery, p.129

The incorrect stitch was given to work the waratah stem. The instruction should read:

Work the stem with three rows of chain stitch using **AE**.



#### ARBOR VITAE

Embroidery, p.91

An incorrect thread was given to work the lower half of the large side petals of the Fringe Lily. The instruction should read:

Leaving a small gap along the upper edge of the shape for the gilt check outline, fill the shape with herringbone stitch using **CN**. Lace the herringbone stitch using **Z**. Work a row of heavy chain along the lower edge of the petal, beginning at the base and using **CN**.

In the index for the step-by-step stitches and stitch glossary on page 198, there was an error in the page numbers indicated for each stitch - each is two pages short of the actual page numbers.

This errata pdf lists the correct page numbers for each stitch.

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
